

Cinque Terre + Tuscany

5-Day Itinerary

Day 1: Pisa

Airport: Arrive at Pisa Intl. Airport. Taxi: \$10-15; Bus: \$1.50

Arrival Time: AM

Hotel: Book 1 night.

Sightseeing: Visit Leaning Tower of Pisa, the Cathedral, and the Baptistery, all located in Piazza dei Miracoli.



Day 2: Riomaggiore, Manarola

Train Station: Catch train to Riomaggiore (La Spezia ->

Riomaggiore: 1h 20m

Hotel: Book 2 nights.

Getting Around: Hike: 1h 30m; Train: 4m; Ferry: 10m

Description: Visit Riomaggiore and Manarola. Hike Lover's Path - Sentiero dell'Amore.



Day 3: Vernazza, Corniglia

Ferry/Train/Hike: Head to Vernazza and Corniglia.

Time: Hike: 1h 30m; Train: 4m; Ferry: 15m

Description: Visit Corniglia. Hike to Vernazza (moderate to strenuous hike). Alternatively, take train or ferry.



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Day 4: Monterosso

Hotel: Spend 1 night in Monterosso

Time: Hike: 1h 30m; Train: 4m; Ferry: 10m

Description: Monterosso is the largest and most accessible village, with a long sandy beach and a flat historical center. It is also the best place to end your hike with a swim in the ocean and a gelato.



Day 5: Pisa & Lucca

Train to Pisa 1h 20m

Hotel: Spend 1 night in Pisa

Train: Head to either Lucca or Florence

Description: It's your last day. You can choose whether to stay in Pisa for the rest of the day, or catch a train to Lucca or Florence and come back to Pisa at night.



Hike

Riomaggiore to Manarolo: 1.5 km(0.0 miles); EASY

Manarola to Corniglia: 3 km (1.86 miles); EASY

Corniglia to Vernazza: 4 km (2.48miles); MODERATE

Vernazza to Monterosso: 3.5 km (2.17miles); MODERATE to DIFFICULT
